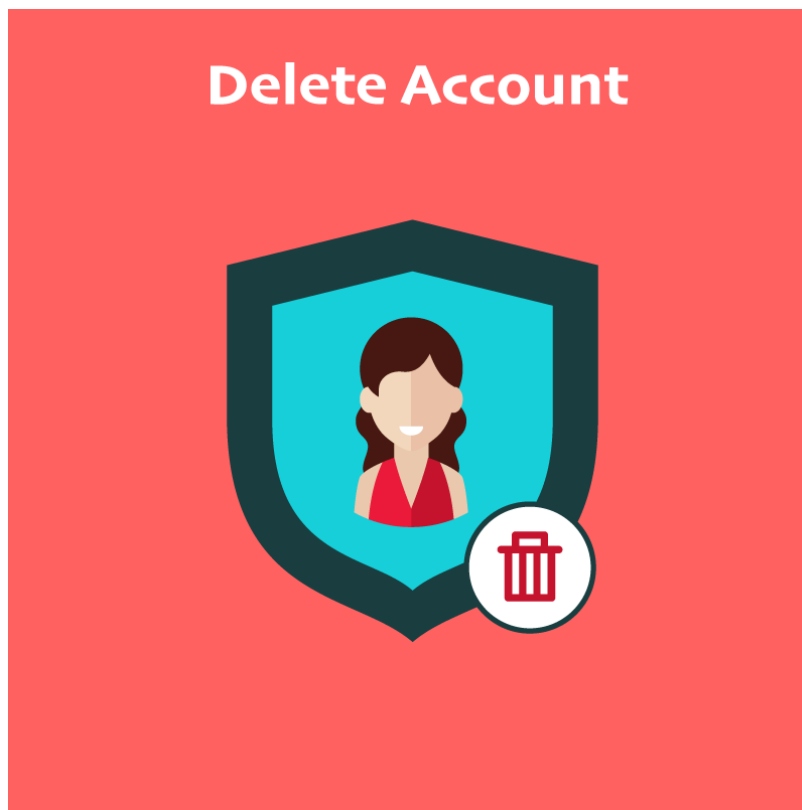


## Delete Account for Magento 2 User Guide


## 1. Extension Installation

- Extract the zip folder and upload our extension to root of your Magento 2 directory via FTP.
- Login to your SSH and run below commands step by step:
  - php bin/magento setup:upgrade
  - For Magento version 2.0.x to 2.1.x - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
  - For Magento version 2.2.x & above - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f
  - php bin/magento cache:flush
- That's it.

## 2. Configuration

To configure the extension, login to Magento backend, move to **Stores → Configuration → Delete Account** where you can find various settings to configure the extension.

- **Delete Account:** Enable or disable the Delete Account extension from here.
- **Email Sender:** Select the Email sender from the drop down list.
- **Email Template:** Select template for delete account confirmation Email sent to customers.

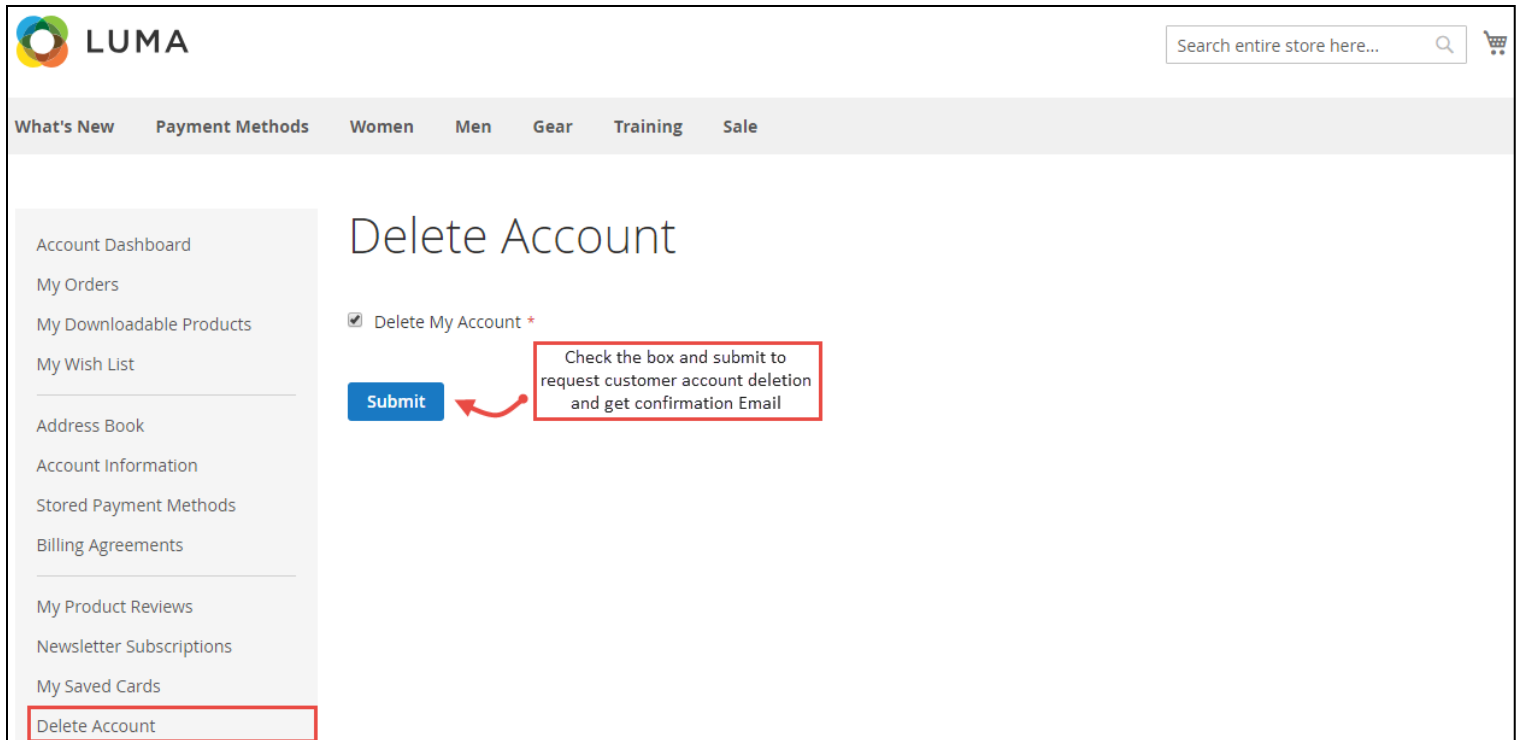

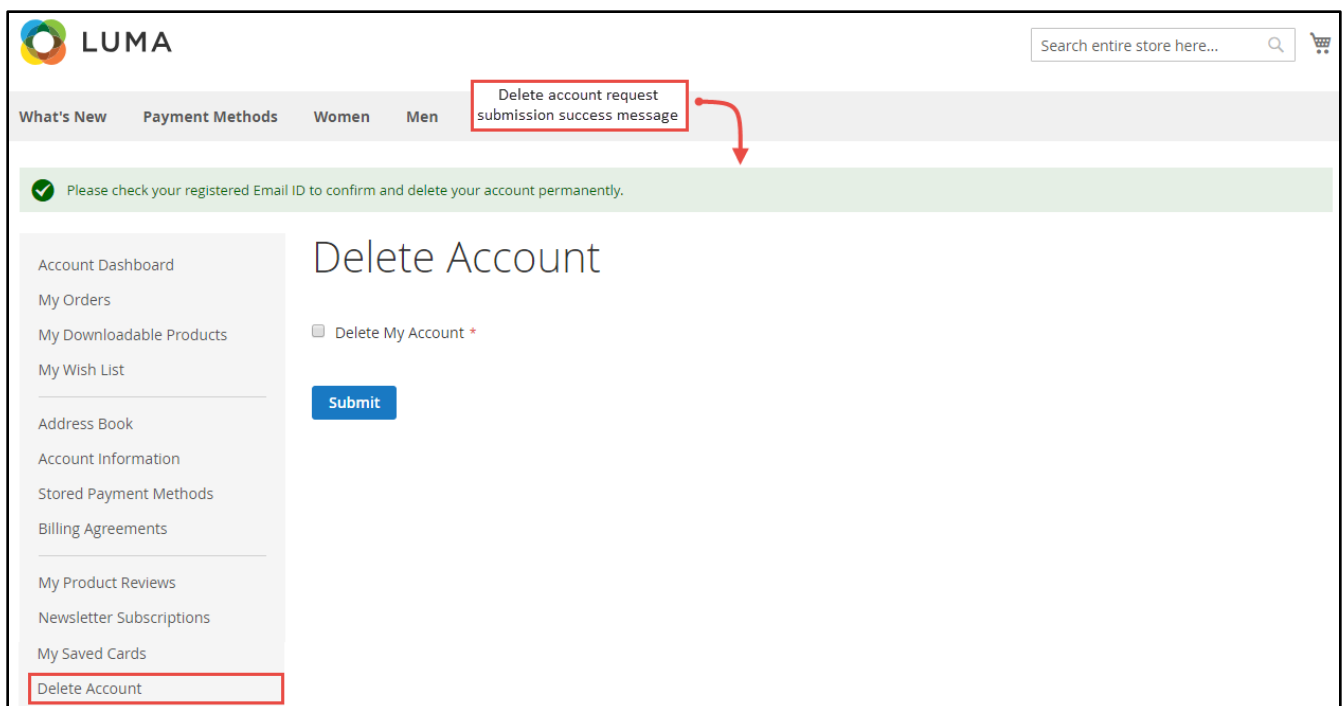

### 3. Delete Account in Frontend

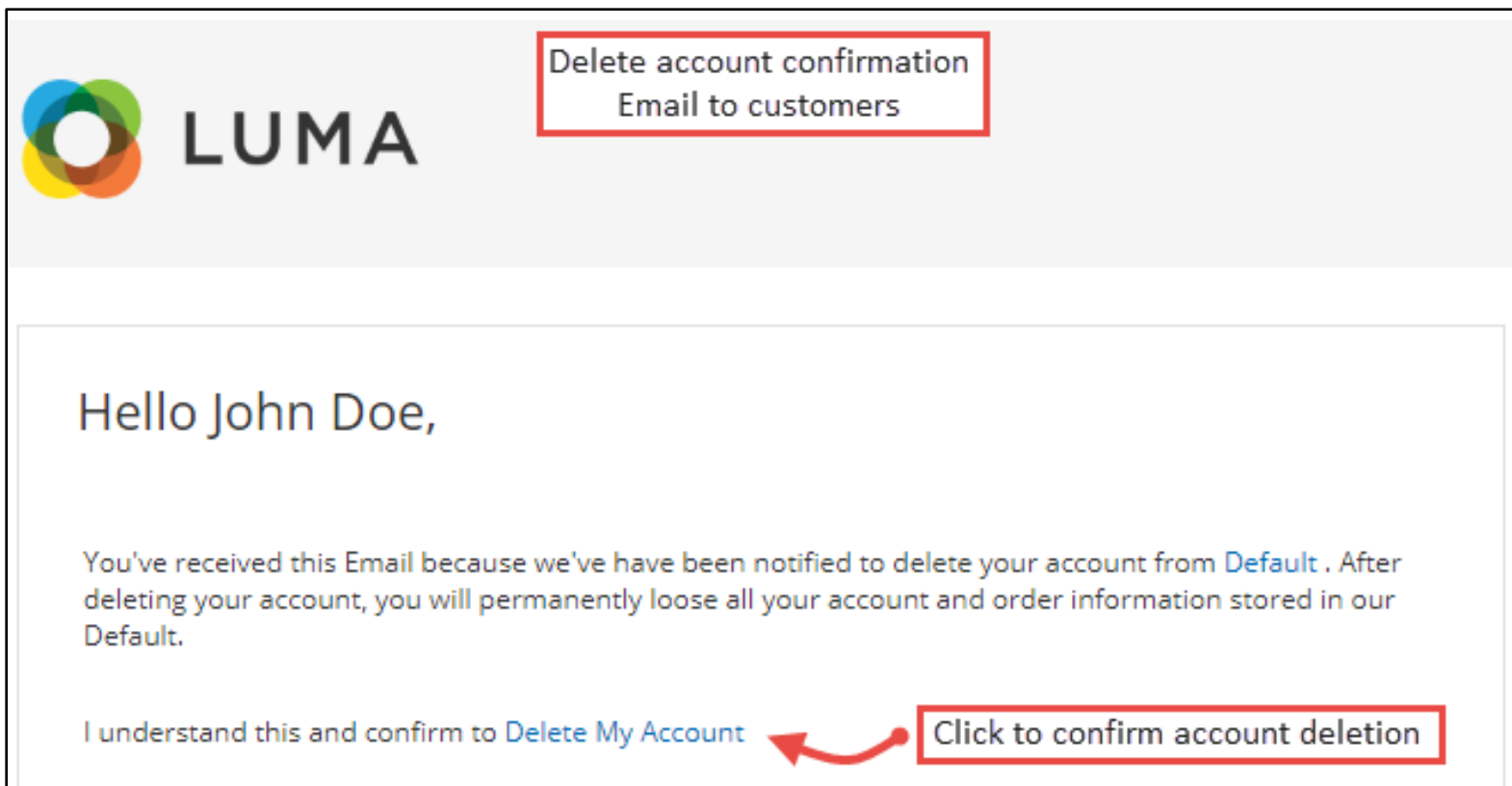


- The following submission success message will be displayed.
